Translation of protocol of conference Europäische Eissegel Union of 13 March 1936

The new sail measurements for the 15 m² Monotype Class

On the basis of a decision in that respect of the properly convened conference of the Europäische Eissegel Union of 13 March 1936 in Angerburg the following measurements for the Monotype Class are determined:

1. The underside of the measurement mark of the masthead is to be fixed 7 meter above deck, measured along the aft side of the mast.
2. The distance between the inside of the mark on the aft end of the boom to the imaginary point of intersection of the aft end of the mast with the lengthened line of the upper side of the boom, measured along the upper side of the boom, amounts to 4,42 meter. – furthermore the following marks have to be attached:
3. 22 cm. below the mast top mark a second mark.
4. 14 cm. more forward than the boom end mark also a second mark.

The measurer when measuring must check the correct distance of the marks of 1 cm. broadness.

Then, with hoisted sail, the distance between the underside of the mast top mark to the boom end mark is measured, whereby the sheet is pulled in tightly. The length measured in this manner may amount to 6,75 meter to 6,85 meter.

Every sail must lie within the two marks on mast and boom.

After checking the prescribed length of the batten pockets the sail then found in accordance with the regulations is stamped in the ... ? corner with the prescribed measurement stamp. ...? are not calculated.

REMARK: every Monotype Ice Yacht built up to the publication of these rules must have their sail marks checked by a measurer in accordance with these rules and must attach the new marks. In so far as the yachts are built and measured accurately in accordance with the drawings, a change of location of the marks worth mentioning should not occur. In the old measurement certificates of all the Monotype Ice Yachts a remark in respect of the above mentioned checking-measurement is to be added. These rules are in force immediately.
